



Realtor Guidelines COVID - 19 Control and Prevention

In an effort to protect the safety and wellness of all Beaver Run Resort employees and visitors, the following guidelines should be followed when on property.

- Call the Property main number at 970-453-6000 with the date and time you would like to show the unit. You will receive instructions on how to obtain keys at this time.
- A business card is required to obtain unit keys. Please return the keys promptly after showing the unit.
- Realtors who are ill cannot show units.
- Clients and realtor must notify management of any travel outside of Summit County or by plane in the last two weeks.
- Where possible, realtors and their clients should take their temperature before they come to Beaver Run. If they have a temperature above 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit, they should stay home and may not visit until they are symptom free for at least three days (72 hours), which is defined as resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications and improvement in respiratory symptoms (e.g. cough, shortness of breath) and, at least seven days have passed since symptoms first appeared.
- Beaver Run Resort may check temperatures onsite, and visitors with temperatures over 100.4 will be sent home and may not return until they are symptom free for at least three days (72 hours), which is defined as resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications and improvement in respiratory symptoms (e.g. cough, shortness of breath) and, at least seven days have passed since symptoms first appeared.
- Practice social/physical distancing, with a minimum of 6 ft. between you and others.
- Visitors must use face coverings which cover the mouth and nose whenever they are on property.
- Clean your hands and anything you touch with disinfectant hand sanitizer or wipes before and after each use.

- Wash your hands frequently.
- Use hand sanitizer if who do not have ready access to soap and water.
- Visitors should not touch their face.
- Utilize gloves when appropriate.
