- Rental Program
 - ✓ The 12-month operational cash flow forecast was reviewed by Rae Anne DeBonville and Joe Shackleton.
 - Rae Anne DeBonville is working with Vectra Bank on originating the SBA CARES
 Act 7(a) loan. The loan can be used for payroll, rent, and utilities and will be
 fully or partially forgiven based on qualifications. The qualification period is
